#### Qualifications

The AFFI District 1 Triton College Paramedic Scholarship Award is solely intended for Loyola Paramedic Program students who want to achieve their Paramedic license. Students who meet all the requirements listed below can apply for this scholarship. This scholarship is exclusively for individuals dedicated to pursuing a career in Fire and EMS service. The scholarship will be awarded to a *maximum of two (2) students*.

- 1. \*Students *must* be enrolled in the Loyola EMS Paramedic Program.
- \*Students *must* live within the Triton College District to qualify for this scholarship. If you have any questions
  about your residency, please contact Triton College for guidance before submitting your application.

- 3. <u>To apply for our scholarship, please request an online application by emailing us at district1.scholarship@gmail.com, scan the QR code below or by filling out the Jotform attached to the email you will receive from your teacher.</u>
- 4. \*\*The scholarship will grant the following amounts based on academic achievement:
  - a. 94 100% (Final Class Grade -A) \$1500.00
  - b. 87 93% (Final Class Grade B) \$1200.00
  - c. 80 86% (Final Class Grade C) \$750.00
    - i. In addition, the individual(s) who achieves the highest academic ranking in their graduating class, known as the Valedictorian, will be granted a supplementary scholarship prize of \$300.00. Similarly, the runner-up in academic ranking, or the Salutatorian, will be awarded a supplementary scholarship prize of \$150.00.
- \*\*To qualify for the AFFI District 1 Triton College Paramedic Scholarship, applicants must meet the requirements mentioned earlier. They must also successfully complete the Loyola Paramedic Program, obtain an Illinois Paramedic License or an equivalent, and receive a passing score. Once these requirements are met, the scholarship will be awarded to pay off any outstanding student loan debt at the College of Dupage. If there is no debt remaining, or if there are any funds left after paying off the debt, the Triton College Foundation will issue a check to the recipient.
- 6. In case the student fails to meet the stated criteria, their scholarship will be revoked. The scholarship funds can then be carried forward to the next year.
